Let us Remember

Bishop Paul Terrio and the people of St. Paul are mourning the untimely and violent death of Rev. Gilbert Dasna, SMMM, Associate Pastor of the St. Paul Cathedral. Bishop Terrio and the faithful of the Diocese of St. Paul pray for the repose of the souls of Father Gilbert and of his alleged assailant as well as for the family and friends of the deceased. Father Gilbert died in his service as a priest to the people of St. Paul at the age of 32. He was born in Cameroun and ordained to the priesthood on July 11, 2009. He served as Associate Pastor of St. Paul Cathedral from May 19, 2011 until his death on May 9, 2014 the third anniversary of his arrival in Canada.
